

## New Policy on Time Away Forms

Our time away policy has changed! If you are not attending D-Now because of time away, please call Andrew or Jim to discuss your conflict. The weekend doesn't start until 8:00 pm on Friday. There are 5 hours of time away allowed during the weekend which means that if you are a basketball player, you can attend your game and Saturday morning practice and still be a part of D-Now. The reason for this policy is to protect the integrity of our small groups throughout the weekend. It is very difficult to maintain continuity, accountability, and a positive environment for our small groups when its members change every session.

While this rule is helpful, it is meant to provide stability and not exclusion so please talk to us if there is any conflict so that we can do everything possible to accommodate the situation.
